Day 1: Arrive Auckland

Welcome to Auckland, known as the 'City of Sails'.

Since you have been flying all night to Auckland we recommend that you arrange for a early check in because international arrivals to New Zealand is between 6 & 9 am in the morning and standard check in time for most hotels and lodges is at 3 pm in the afternoon.

Once processing through immigrations and customs – you will be met by a shuttle driver that will take you to your city hotel. For this package accommodations are provided at the Grand Chancellor Hotel in downtown Auckland.

On day 1 we suggest that wonder the waterfront where you will find excellent restaurants, clubs and stores and since this is called the "City of Sails" let us arrange a cruise on one of the racing yachts in Auckland harbor.

Optional Tours:

Waiheke Island

Your tour guide will drive you to three premier and well known wineries - Mudbrick, Ridgeview Estate and Te Whau. From the vineyards take in the breathtaking views of the city landscape and across to the Hauraki Gulf. At Ridgeview Estate, enjoy a vineyard tour and then sample a platter of mouth watering finger food.

Waitomo Glowworm Caves

Travel south from Auckland through the rich farmland of the Waikato on to Waitomo. Enjoy a guided tour through the long galleries and lofty chambers of the World Famous Glowworm Caves. Your tour continues with a boat ride through the Glowworm Grotto, illuminated by thousands of tiny lights from the glow worms suspended from the cave ceiling. Following your tour there is time for lunch (lunch available as a pre-booked option). Return to Auckland by coach.

Auckland - Bay of Islands - Cape Reinga Fly / Drive Day Tour

Departure time from Sky City in central Auckland would be 0630am. A breakfast box will be provided on the transfer coach. You will then be transferred to meet your aircraft for a 7.15am departure. Your flight time to the Bay of Islands is approximately 55 minutes, incorporating a brief stop in Whangarei for passengers leaving the aircraft here. From the Bay of Islands we continue up the West coast via the world famous 90 mile beach. We land at Cape Reinga from where you depart on a 2½ hour tour exploring this magical area by comfortable air conditioned vehicle. An opportunity to experience the exhilaration of sand tobogganing is offered on this portion of the tour. A light refreshment is also included. Rejoin the aircraft for the next leg of your flight via the east coast route to the Bay of Islands. You will view some of the most stunning coastal scenery Northland has to offer, flying over Parengarenga Harbour and Great Exhibition Bay. This remote area is without a doubt one of the most beautiful places in New Zealand with it's pure white silica sand and crystal clear water, much of it accessible only by sea or air. We fly on over Houhora Harbour, the Cavalli Islands, Kauri Cliffs golf course, and the spectacular Bay of Islands. From the Bay of Islands/Kerikeri airport a courtesy vehicle will take you to Paihia, the hub of the Bay of Islands for a few hours in the afternoon. Feel free to explore this historical area, walk along the beautiful beach or do some shopping. At a pre-arranged time you we will take you to your aircraft for the return flight to Auckland. This leg of the flight will follow the west coast route south from Kerikeri to Auckland via the Kaipara Harbour, before landing in Auckland for transfer back to your hotel.
